

2013 South Beach Road Association Annual Meeting Follow-up September 2013

The list below describes the status of some of the items that were discussed at the Annual Meeting.

- 1) The web addresses for the Tillamook County Assessor's Office and Surveyor's Office have been added to the SBRA website.
- 2) The Water District abutment described as being in the middle of the beach access at Nescove Dr. and Surf was a water meter vault temporarily set in the walkway prior to installation. It has been moved.
- 3) The engineering firms that bid on the permitting and environmental studies phase of the bridge repair state that the permits can be issued to the SBRA and Proposal Rock Homeowners Association. The bridge owner (Bob Fultz) would have to sign the permit application before it could be submitted and approved.
- 4) The quotes for the permitting and environmental studies for the bridge repair have been posted on the SBRA website.
- 5) A \$50 donation has been sent to the South Tillamook County Emergency Volunteer Corps.
- 6) The speed limit sign that was posted in the wrong direction has been turned around.
- 7) The beach access at the north end of Nescove Dr. was repaired (Thanks, Ken Graham).
- 8) The Neskowin Sanitation District has decided to abandon the sewer line located along the east side of South Beach Road south of South Beach Point. The line will be relocated to the ditch along the west side of the road. Repair of South Beach Road will not begin until the Sanitation District has completed its work.
- 9) A construction engineer from OBEC Engineering will be visiting the bridge October 8th to gather information for preparing an estimate for repairing the bridge.
